Thanks to our many supporters our new Fire Engine arrived early 2014 but we still have a long way to go in accomplishing the full payoff of the unit. Another area that future funds will go towards is the purchase of

new SCBA units used for breathing and protection in fire, smoke, and other hazardous environments. The SCBA units will cost about \$5,000 per unit with about 12 needing to be upgraded in the near future.
